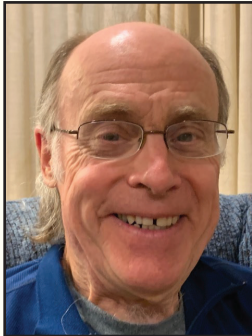

Hello to all Riverbay Friends and Neighbors,


